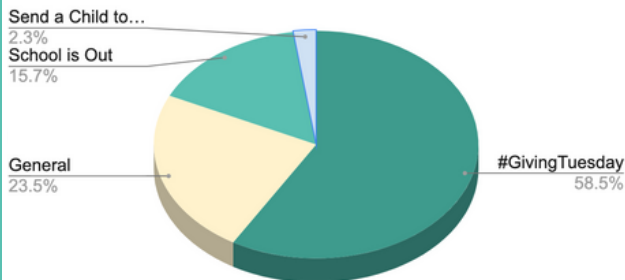
~A FAMILY'S STORY~

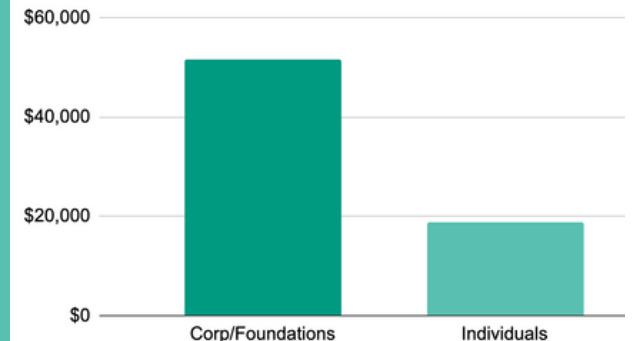
