~A FAMILY'S STORY~

My second year of teaching, 3 year old twins, Alaina and Alex, were enrolled in my classroom. They were small for their age, quiet, with an underdeveloped vocabulary, and Alex had a speech impediment. Alex spent the first week or so crying upon arrival, needing to be coaxed into the classroom each morning. After a couple of weeks, they both started to feel comfortable in the classroom. The Montessori environment, one-onone support from staff and volunteers, and attention to their basic needs allowed both of them to blossom. They picked up the rhythm of the Montessori method immediately.

We watched them gain independence in their self care, care of others, and care of their environment. They soaked up math concepts and their vocabulary grew every day. Inside those small, quiet children was a whole world just waiting to be cracked open. That is what Mustard Seed aims to do - provide a safe, nurturing space where kids have an opportunity to thrive.

- 3. The Preschooler's future children


